ADMISSION CRITERIA

To be eligible for admission into the Nurse Educator Certificate Track at Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia, the applicant must submit the following documentation:

- Submit an application through the Nursing application system
- Submit official college transcripts through the Nursing CAS portal documenting a Masters if applying in conjunction with the Doctor of Nursing Practice Completion Program or Doctorate degree if applying only for the Nurse Educator Track.
- CRNA licensure

Admitted students in the Nurse Educator Certificate Program, the DNAP Completion Program or simultaneously enrolled in both the DNAP Completion Program and the Nurse Educator Track or the DNAP Completion Program and the Acute Surgical Pain Management Fellowship may be eligible for HRSA Faculty Nurse Loan program (FNLP) with a nurse educator employment commitment postgraduation which provides up to 85% loan forgiveness for up to 4 years employment as Nursing faculty when educator employment is completed.
